### **MULTI-HAZARD RISK ASSESSMENT AND ZONATION** **OF** **JAMNAGAR CITY AND NEIGHBORHOOD**

Government of Gujarat (GOG) has decided to initiate a study on Multi-hazard Risk Assessment and Zonation of Jamnagar City and Neighborhood for a period of 9 months. The main objective of the study is to develop city-wide hydro-meteorological risk mitigation models for the coastal cities and developing hazard risk and vulnerability models and development of mitigation measures to reduce the impacts of cyclones, floods and Tsunami for the Jamnagar city and the neighboring areas, which can be further extended to other cities of the state.

**GSDMA invites EOI from consultants for the above service. The consultants should have carried out assignments of similar type / work to meet industry standards. Working experience with multilateral funding agencies is desirable.**

**Interested consultants must provide following information indicating that they are qualified to perform the services:**

- Having a minimum of 5 (five) years of professional experience in similar projects.
- At the most up to ten (10) project profiles of similar assignments undertaken by the consultants including relevant project profiles of project performed by sub-consultants or JV partners, as the case may be. If more than ten profiles are submitted then only first ten in seriatim will be evaluated.
- Availability of appropriate skills among staff in the form of their CVs mentioning only similar assignments undertaken. Proposed key personnel for this assignment should be familiar with the geographical areas of Gujarat.
- Company brochures or any other relevant information including details of office automation facilities specific to this project.

Consultants may associate to enhance their qualifications. *[The 'Association' may take the form of a Joint Venture (with joint and several liability) or of a sub-consultancy].*

**Consultants will be selected in accordance with the procedures set out by the Project Sanction and Approval Committee of GSDMA based on the EOIs received and evaluated.**

**Suitable shortlisted firms will be issued RFP documents for submission of detailed financial and technical proposal.**
