1. This Invitation for Bids follows the General Procurement Notice for this Project that appeared in Development Business, issue no. 569 of 31 October 2001.

2. The Government of India has received a credit from the International Development Association (IDA) toward the cost of Gujarat Emergency Earthquake Reconstruction Project, and it intends to apply part of the proceeds of this credit to payments under the Contract for **Procurement of Mini Fire Tender and Water Bowser**.

3. The Gujarat State Disaster Management Authority now invites sealed bids from eligible and qualified bidders for BID-I, and BID-II. The BID-I is Procurement of Mini Fire Tender having three Lots 42 number of Mini Fire Tender in each Lot and the BID-II is Procurement of Water Bowser also having three Lots 45 number of Water Bowser in each Lot.

4. Bidding will be conducted through the International Competitive Bidding (ICB) procedures specified in the World Bank's Guidelines: Procurement under IBRD Loans and IDA Credits, and is open to all bidders from Eligible Source Countries as defined in the Guidelines.

5. Interested eligible bidders may obtain further information from Shri Rajesh Kishore, IAS, Chief Executive Officer, Gujarat State Disaster Management Authority, e-mail: [ceo-gsdma@gujarat.gov.in](mailto:ceo-gsdma@gujarat.gov.in) and inspect the Bidding Documents at the address given below from 10.30 AM to 5.30 PM on all the working days. The bidders may request for any clarification twenty-one days prior to dateline for submission of bids. The pre-bid conference which will be held on 8<sup>th</sup> October, 2007 at 12.00 noon for BID-I and 8<sup>th</sup> October, 2007 at 2.30 p.m. for BID-II. The venue for pre-bid conference will be Committee Room, GSDMA, Gandhinagar. The bidders are also requested to visit official website of GSDMA frequently i.e. [www.gsdma.org](http://www.gsdma.org) for response to clarifications (if any).

6. Qualifications requirements include Financial and technical capability stipulated in the bidding documents. A margin of preference for certain goods manufactured domestically shall be applied. Additional details are provided in the Bidding Documents.

7. A complete set of Bidding Documents in English may be purchased by interested bidders on the submission of a written Application to the address below and upon payment of a non refundable fee INR 6000/- (USD 150.00) only for BID-I and INR 7000/- (USD 175.00) only for BID-II. The method of payment will be Demand Draft/bankers cheque/Direct Deposit (State Bank of Saurashtra, RTGS: SSAU0001228 Ac. No. 56228002981) ONLY payable to **"Gujarat State Disaster Management Authority"** at Ahmedabad/Gandhinagar. The Bidding Documents will be sent by airmail for overseas

delivery and Indian Postal Services for local delivery. The postage charges will be extra INR 500/- for the postage within the country and USD 25/- for other countries. GSDMA will not be responsible for any delay due to postal service.

Interested bidder may also download the PDF version of bid document from GSDMA website [www.gsdma.org](http://www.gsdma.org) and submit the Bid Purchase fees separately as mentioned in above paragraph. In case of non receipt of Bid Purchase fee before or along with the bid offer, the bid will be treated as non responsive. Electronic bidding will not be permitted. Late bids will be rejected. Bids will be opened in the presence of the bidders' representatives, who choose to attend in person at the address below at 2.30 p.m. 29<sup>th</sup> October, 2007 for BID-I and 3.30 p.m. 29<sup>th</sup> October, 2007 for BID-II. All bids must be accompanied by a bid security as given in BDS 21.2 of Section-II.
