Do's	Don'ts
When you notice a fire raise alarm 'FIRE' at the top of your voice. Evacuate calmly and quickly.	Do not run in panic. Do not continue to use LPG cylinder for cooking etc., in near vicinity of fire.
If you encounter smoke during your evacuation, stay low to the floor. Use staircase only to reach ground floor.	Do not use lift/elevator.
Inform Fire & Emergency Services from safe location by calling 101.	Do not take undue risk. Do not crowd the scene of fire.
As far as possible try to attract other's attention on your way to the scene of fire.	Do not tamper with any machinery during fire fighting. Leave them for authorised handling.
One who reaches first at the scene of fire should make sure that no life is trapped.	Do not argue or discuss at the scene of fire.
Try to put-off the small fire with the nearest appropriate type of fire extinguishers. Water, CO2 fire extinguisher for general fire and foam type extinguisher for oil fires. CO2 fire extinguisher for electrical fire only.	Do not tamper with equipment, if you do not know its operation.
